

ESTIMATED TIMELINE FOR CLYDE'S 10K

The Clyde's American 10K Race is a 6.2 mile road race that takes place on Sunday, April 15, 2018, starting at 8:00 AM, in downtown Columbia. The course goes around the Columbia Mall, up to Columbia Road, left onto the shoulder of Route 108, before it loops back, through Running Brook, to a dramatic new Lakefront finish in front of Clyde's. This new finish will reduce the impact of the race on Town Center traffic compared with the old finish at the pedestrian bridge on Little Patuxent Parkway.

The following timeline for anticipated paces is only an estimate, as rolling road closures will impact certain locations, to allow safe passage for the runners. There will be some gaps, or breaks, which may allow for some vehicular traffic, but it's impossible to predict when gaps might occur. The range in time allows for the fastest to the slowest runners, and are merely the best estimate possible.

8:00 – Start on Little Patuxent Parkway near Wincopin Circle (on the Mall Side of the LPP)

8:05 - 8:15 – Mile 1 - Little Patuxent Parkway(LPP) & Governor Warfield Parkway

8:10 - 8:30 – Mile 2 – LPP, just before Columbia Road

8:15 - 8:45 – Mile 3 – Columbia Road, about the clubhouse

8:20 - 9:00 – Mile 4 - Route 108, approaching Ten Mills

8:25 - 9:15 – Mile 5 – West Running Brook, approaching Running Brook ES

8:30 - 9:30 – Mile 6.2 – Clyde's of Columbia!

Please keep in mind, these are estimates, actual closures may differ, and access to travel lanes can vary.
